EFS FOR MAC

INSTALLATION:

- 1) Go to your "Downloads" folder in the Finder. You will find the "EFSDesktopSoftware" file. Right click (Two finger click) on the icon and select "Show Package Contents".
- 2) In the Package Contents,
 - Double-click on Contents folder
 - Double-click on Resources folder
 - Double-click on Java folder
- 3) In the Java Folder, Right Click (Two Finger Click) on the "EFSDesktopSoftware.jar" file and select "Make Alias" option.
- 4) A new file "EFSDesktopSoftware.jar alias" is created. Then, Drag the "EFSDesktopSoftware.jar alias" file onto your Desktop.
- 5) Close the Finder, double-click on the "EFSDesktopSoftware.jar alias" file on your Desktop, Then the EFS Software will open.

IMPORTANT!

- You will be Using the "EFSDesktopSoftware.jar alias" file on your Desktop to use the Software.
- You should not DELETE the "EFSDesktopSoftware" file in your Downloads folder. As that file is the main application.

Some Users might get an error while opening the application, saying "The app can't be opened because it is from an unidentified developer". PLEASE FOLLOW THE INSTRUCTIONS BELOW:

- 1) You will see an error pop up, saying the app can't be opened because it is from an unidentified developer. Click the "OK" button on the box.
- 2) Click on the Apple logo on the Top Right Corner, Select "System Preferences".
- 3) In the System Preferences, Click on "Security & Privacy".
- In the "Security & Privacy", Under "General" tab, Click on "Open Anyway".
- 5) You will see a pop-up, asking if you want to open it, click "Open" and close the "System Preferences" window.
- 6) Now Double-Click on the "EFSDesktopSoftware.jar alias" icon on your Desktop. The EFS Software window will open.
