

## Java Installation Guide for Windows Users:

1. First, go to <http://www.elections.ny.gov/CFFileReports.html>. To download Java, click on the “Download Java” link, which will open a web page on the Java.com website.

#### Important:

Before installing the Electronic Filing System Software, you may need to first install Java if it is not already installed on your computer.

Java 6 or higher is needed for the installation of the Electronic Filing System (EFS).

#### Java Browser Plugin Vulnerabilities:

As you may have read, vulnerabilities in the Java Web Browser Plugin have been found to affect recent versions of Java, including Java 6 and 7. The electronic filing system (EFS) does not use the browser plugin and is not affected by this problem. Users who are concerned about the Java Browser Plugin should know that it is possible to disable it.


5. If you click on “Run”, the “Welcome to Java” screen will appear. If you click on “Save”, you will see the screen below where a security scan will be performed on the file first.




6. After the download has completed, click on the “Open folder” button at the bottom.




7. The Windows Explorer window will be displayed, double-click on the Java setup file.




8. The “Welcome to Java” screen will appear. Click on the “Install” button.




9. It may take a couple of minutes for the installer to download.



10. You do not need to install the browser add-on from Ask.com. Make sure that the checkboxes are unchecked, then click on the “Next” button.




11. The Java installation process will begin, which may take a few minutes.




12. During the installation process, a green status bar will appear.

14. On the Java verification page, you will be prompted to enable a plug-in. Click on “Don’t enable”.




15. On the Java verification page, click on the “Agree and Continue” button to start the Java verification process.


